Financial Report for the Year Ended 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021

I have pleasure in presenting my second Report as Divisional Treasurer for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021.

After this past year of 'lock down' there can be no other expectation than the Income exceeded the Expenditure by £880.02. In fact the only expenditure was that which was required for administration purposes totalling £108.22.

The Division made a donation of £250.00 to the Grand Sovereigns, Care for Children fund. Which leaves a balance on the Alms Account of £225.06.

The bank balances at 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021 was £5,550.32, of which £5,325.26 represented the General Account.

In view of the current situation, I do not anticipate any exceptional expenditure; I therefore recommend that there be NO increase in Divisional dues for the forth coming year.
